Q: Is the Network for Teaching Entrepreneurship (NFTE) issued credential considered an industry recognized credential?

A: No. The NFTE credential is not an industry recognized credential. It would not fulfill the “credential attainment” performance measure, but could be utilized towards the “entrepreneurial skills training” program element.

Q: Will you accept the American Culinary Foundation (ACF) Certificate of Culinary Fundamentals as industry recognized credential?

A: Yes. The American Culinary Foundation (ACF) Certificate of Culinary Fundamentals is an industry recognized credential. It would fulfill the “credential attainment” performance measure.

Please note, the ServSafe Food Handler certificate issued by the National Restaurant Association is not an industry recognized credential under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
