**WIOA Youth Program Providers - Questions and Answers**

**Q: Regarding the out-of-school RFP, can WIOA funding cover the cost of college credit classes during the summer session which students generally cannot cover through financial aid?**

**A: No. WIOA funded cannot be used to cover college credit classes.**

**Q: Are students served through an educational agency by a WIOA Out-of-School program eligible for Individual Training Accounts (ITAs) to cover training?**

**A: At the release of the RFP, the region has not yet received its funding allocation and cannot guarantee ITA training funds will be available in FY'19. If the GWLDB sets aside ITA training funds, the funding would be available for all youth program providers on a first come, first served basis.**

**A bidder can incorporate occupational skills training in their program design and would include the cost of the training in their respective budget.**
